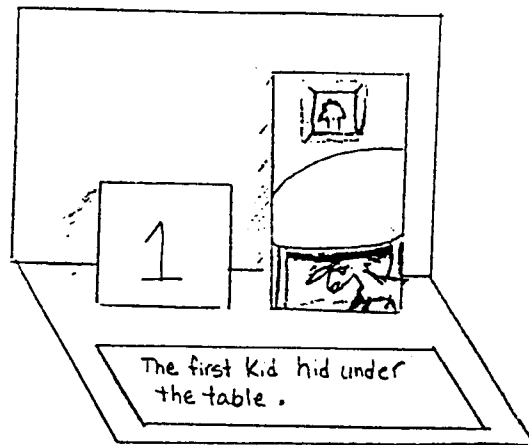


Pop-Up Book

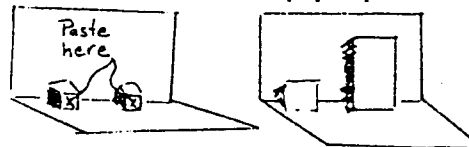


Procedure

1. Duplicate Pop-Up Pattern on the following page. Follow the cutting and folding instructions.
2. Cut seven pieces of construction paper 3" x 3". Write the numbers one thru seven on each one. In groups of seven, give each student a number card and a 3" x 4" piece of construction paper. The student will draw a picture of the number the kid was hiding at when the wolf got in their house.



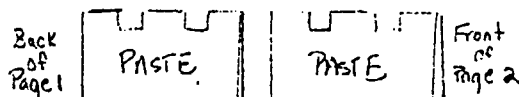
Open the pop-up pattern page. Place paste on the FRONT of the pop-up tab. Place the alphabet letter and picture on the paste.



3. Students will write a sentence explaining where the billy kid was hiding on a strip of handwriting paper. Paste it on the bottom of the pop-up pattern page.

4. Collect student pages and place in numerical order. Paste the back of page one to the front of page two. Continue this procedure with the remainder of the pages.



Then cut a piece of 9" x 12" construction paper to fit as a cover. Paste it in place.

POP-UP PATTERN DIRECTIONS



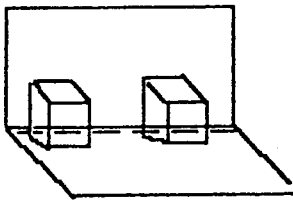
1. Fold on fold A.



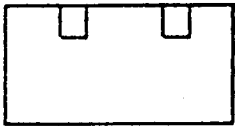
2. Cut on the solid lines.



3. Fold on the B's.



4. Open the paper and push the tabs to the inside, and fold B on the pop-up portion.



5. Hold and pull the pop-up tabs from the inside. Close and press folds.
