

# Journey Along the Nile

Grade: 6

Time: Three class periods of 50 minutes each

Geographic Theme

Journeying along the Nile to learn about ancient Egypt.

Objective

The students will be able to prepare a travel agenda for visiting Egypt.

#### Materials

- Ancient Egypt Field Trip Guide
- Pen or pencil
- Paper
- Overhead projector
- Transparencies
- Markers
- Construction paper
- Colored pencils
- Glue sticks
- Other books about Egypt

#### **Procedures**

1. Initiating Activity: Read article page 11 of *Field Trip Guide*: "Follow the Clues to an Ancient Cemetery"

### 2. Strategies

- A. Culminating activity
- B. Remind of cooperative learning roles
- C. Divide them into groups of three
- D. Directions
- E. Pick roles: leader, timekeeper, materials (all secretary and encouragers)
- F. Materials person get supplies necessary
- 3. Culminating Activity: Journey Along the Nile travelog project (directions given on overhead, take questions to check understanding). Six days writing in a journal with decorations and pictures.

#### Evaluation

The student will receive two project grades- one for the group product- the actual travel journal, and one for the individual participation and work during the project.

## TRAVELING DOWN THE NILE Journal Project

Using the information from your Ancient Egypt Field Trip guide and other books provided, write a journal for a three day trip on the Nile. Write about:

- 1. What happens to you along the way.
- 2. What adventures you have when you encounter different things.
- 3. How you travel.
- 4. Describe the land, weather, animals, and plants, etc.

The whole point is to BE CREATIVE- let your imagination fly!

Please include illustrations relating to your experiences on each of your days in the journal.

2 GRADES: 1 for the JOURNAL (project) and 1 for Individual Participation and work within the group.

When working in groups, there are ROLES:

- Leader- Keeps everyone on task and working on what they are supposed to, so they get the work done, when due.
- **Timekeeper** Keeps track of time- watches clock for cleanup time and signals group.
- Materials person- Gets ALL the materials needed for the group (should be the only person up out of his/her seat).
- Today- All of you will also take on the following roles:
  - Secretary- Write down the information, readable handwriting.
    Each person will have the opportunity to write one day in the journal.
  - Encourager- Encourages the people in the group (ex. Good idea! Nice input! etc.)
  - Maintenance Director- Makes sure everything is cleaned up and gets everyone to help clean up.
